The reader can thus quickly understand where Australia fits into the regional and global perspective. The report first investigates the economic fundamentals affecting Australia. These fundamentals are the source for Australia's latent demand. Then, the subsequent chapters detail Australia's accessibility. This evaluation covers a number of entry alternatives, including export strategies, and local direct investment strategies. If a firm decides to have a local presence in Australia, this requires a strategic understanding of local business conditions. The conditions investigated in this report include local marketing (advertising, distribution, pricing issues) and entry strategies (opening an office, joint venturing, etc.), as well as human resources management (labor laws, costs, regulations). ...
